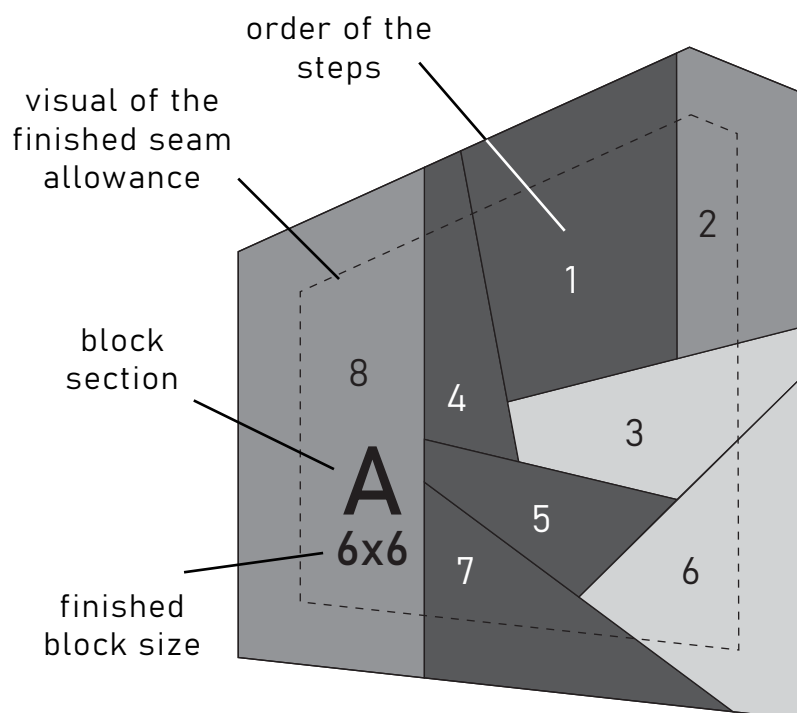

COLOR GUIDE

Below is how the shades of gray in the templates relate to the colors portrayed on the front cover of the pattern. Write the colors of fabric you will use next to their coordinating shades of gray.

WHITE



BLUE



TAN

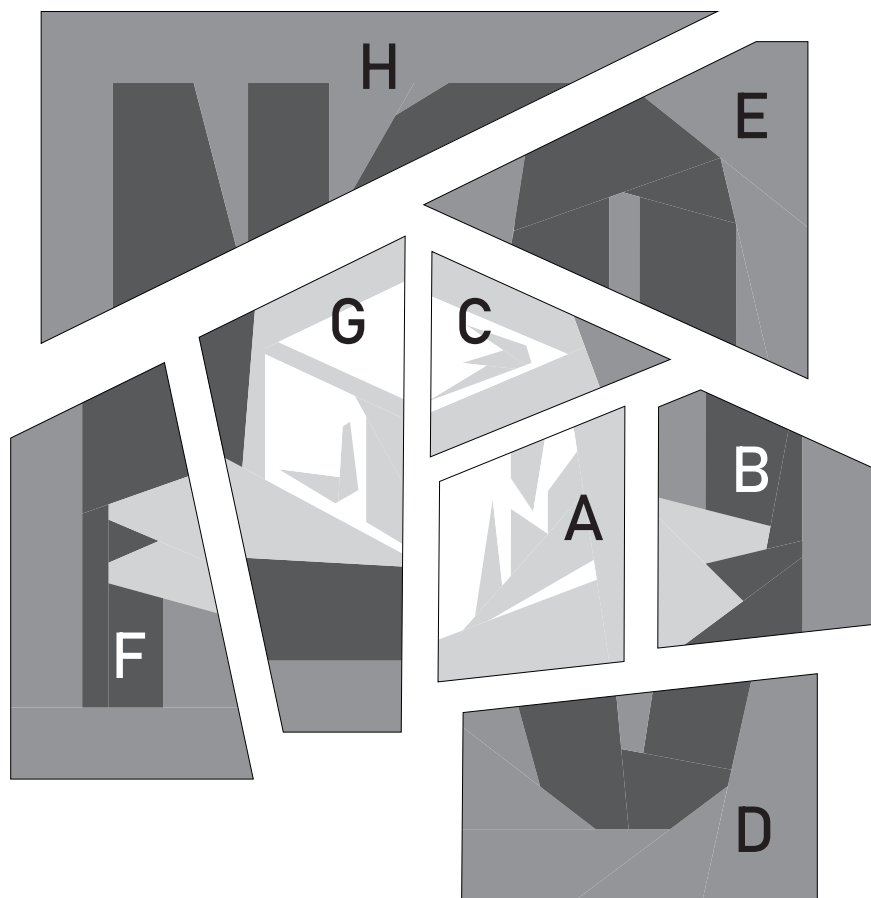


RED

COMPLETING THE BLOCK



The beveled edges of the templates enable them to pair up perfectly.

Sew Section A to Section B.

Sew Section C to Section A/B.

Sew Section D to Section A/B/C.

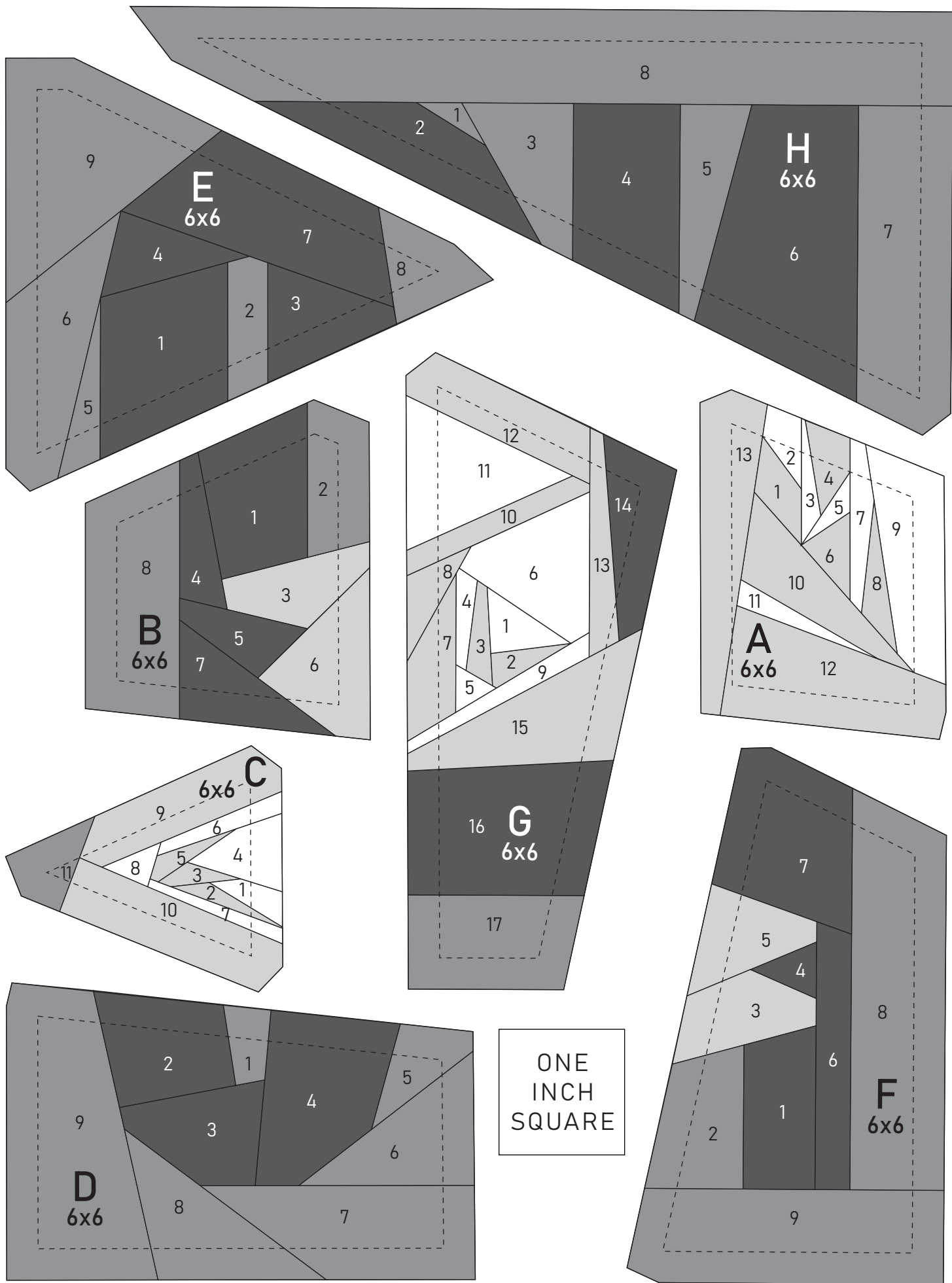
Sew Section E to Section A/B/C/D.

Sew Section F to Section G.

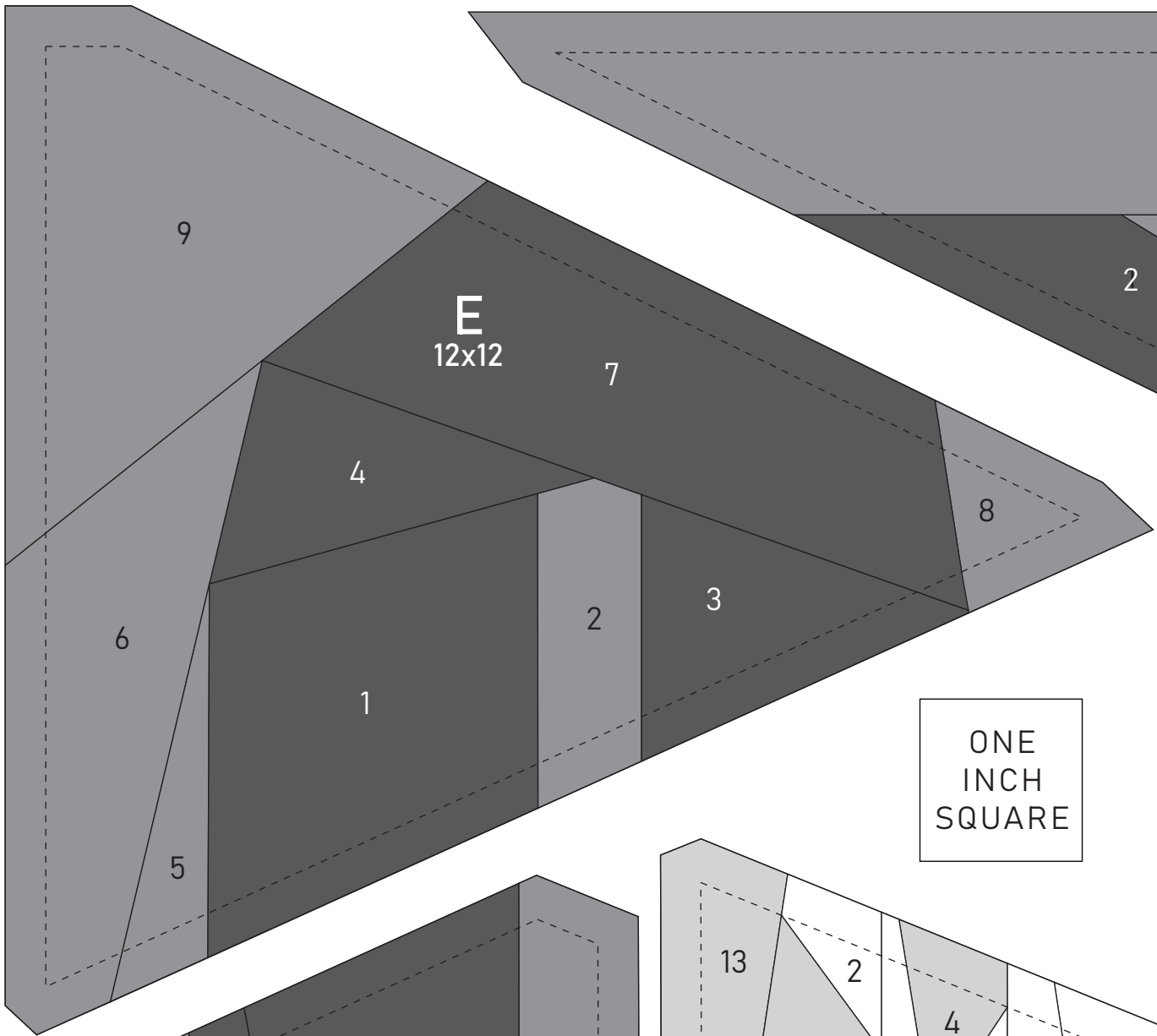
Sew Section F/G to Section A/B/C/D/E.

Sew Section H to Section A/B/C/D/E/F/G.

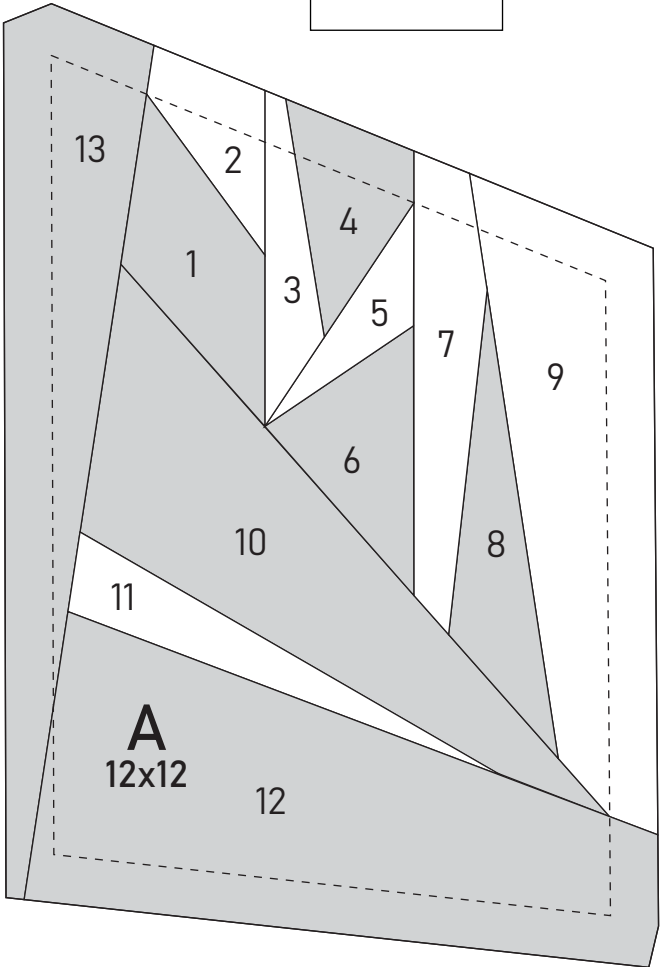
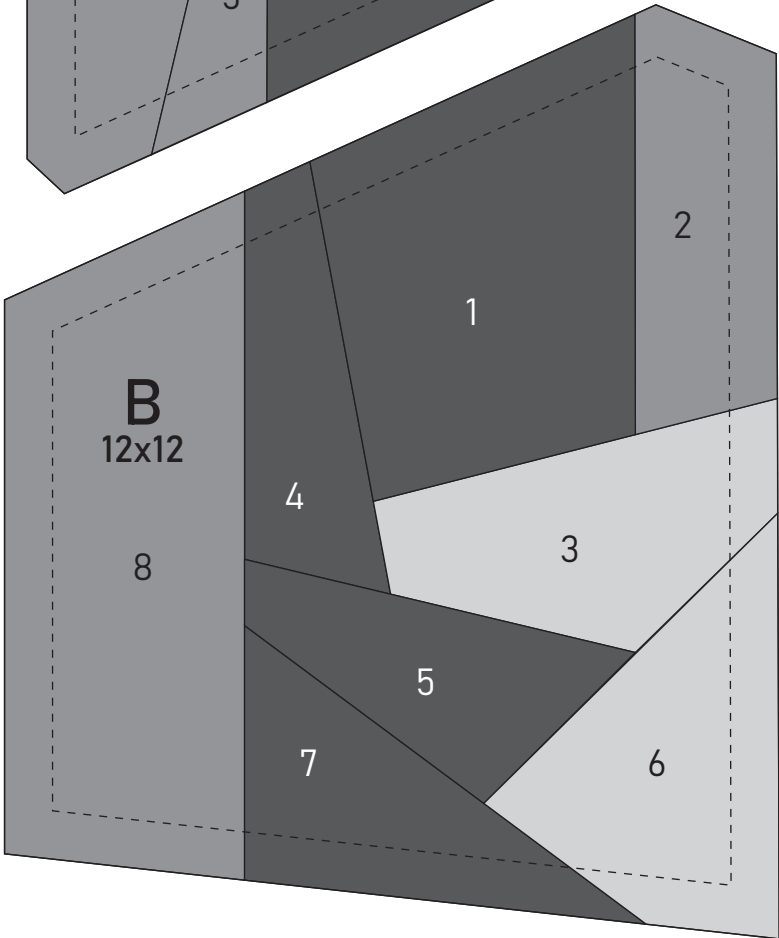
